For the Boys, Gervacio Maldonado qualified in the 300M Dash (41.57), and Brennan Delany, who came within .08 seconds of a personal best, qualified in the 55M Hurdles (9.37) and the High Jump (4-9). Setting personal bests this season were: Reyman Clair (24-05.5) and Brianna Beebe (19-04) in the Girls Shot Put, Kaela Briggs in the 1000M (4:42.58) and 1500M (7:08.42) Runs, Quinn Stillman in the 600M Run (1:51.29) and the 1600M Run (5:36.00), Gervacio Maldonado in the 55M Dash (7.34), and Jacob Ponticello in the Shot Put (32-09.5) and the 55M Dash (7.86).
